- One (1) pdf. Copy, emailed to M.J. Randolph : mrandolph@town.northlake.tx.us , of a plot plan accurately reflecting the location of all proposed fences, all easements, building setback lines, and visibility triangles
- One (1) pdf. copy of photo/s and/or drawing/s depicting fence to be constructed
- Fence Permit Fee of \$100 is due prior to issuance of permit

Permits are subject to all applicable codes and ordinances of the Town of Northlake. Detailed fencing requirements can be found in Section 9.11, Screening and Fencing, of Article 9, Design Standards, of the Northlake Unified Development Code (UDC)
